

NEW DISPOSAL RULES AT THE TYRINGHAM
TRANSFER STATION

The Tyringham Transfer Station

In order to be more efficient will implement the following changes:

The Transfer Station will accept white goods except:

Refrigerators

Freezers

Air Conditioners

Dehumidifiers

All of which contain Freon

**These can be taken to Lenox Valley WTF Waste /Recycling Facility in
Lenoxdale.**

The fees for disposal are:

Refrigerator - \$25.00 / Freezer (chest or upright) \$25.00

Air conditioner - \$15.00 / Dehumidifiers - \$15.00

**The Transfer Station will NO LONGER accept mattresses, box springs,
sofas or stuffed chairs.**

**These can be disposed of at Lenox Valley WTF at no cost to the
resident. The Lenox Valley WTF will bill the town for these items
dropped off by residents of Tyringham**
