Board of Health Meeting Minutes--Town Hall, 116 Main Road

The mail was read, previous minutes were approved.

Trustees of Reservation - Joanna Ballantine, Regional Director and Thomas Por Operations Manager along with Larry Bravo, Tyringham Properties Committee member, were to discuss the plans for the Ashintully property on Main Road. This property was not left with a very big endowment and therefore they are looking for ways to generate revenue for the upkeep and maintenance. The current plan is to keep the fields mowed, replace the bridge over the brook that was washed away with a flood, the flower gardens will remain and walking paths hopefully created. They would like to also link the McLennan reservation with Ashintully. Recently, a wedding was held and a dinner was also held on premise. There are no current permits or licenses for this property and the Board wanted to discuss the future plans in relation to alcohol and food. The Selectmen also asked the Planning Board to attend this meeting as a "special permit" may be required depending on the use. A discussion ensued regarding the future plans for Ashintully. The Selectmen directed the Trustees to meet with the Planning Board regarding a "special permit" and informed them that Alcohol Permits were issued by the Selectmen and a food permit is required thru the Board of Health when establishments are serving food.
