Gerard Miller made a motion that transfer station employees will fall under the jurisdiction of the highway superintendent, Christopher Johnson seconded, no opposition.


SEPTIC PERMITS:

C. Frank septic repair permit was approved for 25 Cooper Creek.

Mike Feeney from the Dept. of Public Health has completed an air quality test at the School House. A full report will be sent to the Town in the next few weeks. Mr. Feeney stated that there is a definite mold odor which he believes is a combination of issues. These issues include water and rot on the SE side of the building and on the SW corner the heating unit is drawing air from under the building and re-distributing it into the building. Also a rug on the floor which has mold and rot. Mr. Feeney suggested the Town contact the Fire Chief and ask him if the combustion air for the furnace adequate? and configured properly? Mr. Feeney contact number is: 617-624-5757 Larry Gould also spoke to Mr. Feeney about his findings at the school house.
