ROAD SALT USAGE:

Everett Fennelly asked about the use of salt on Town Roads and asked if the Town's usage has gone down. Noah Choquette stated the trucks were calibrated and the usage has been cut in 1/2 per lane mile.

VERIZON:

The Verizon box on Main Road (in front of David Carriers) is very large and Mr. Carrier asked about putting a shrub in front of it. This issue will need further investigation.

RAISE REQUEST: Christopher Johnson stated that Bill Roche was in to discuss his pay vs. what the Town of Lee advertised for a new hire. A discussion ensued regarding wages. It was decided to further investigate this issue. It was also discussed to look into compensating Bill for not enrolling into the Town's Health Insurance.


FINANCE COMMITTEE: A review of the FY17 budget ensued. April 5th next budget meeting.
