SCHOOL:

School Superintendency Union #29 Lee-Tyringham submitted the 2016-2017 tuition rates which will remain the same as last year. \$6,422.68 per student.

Matthew Punting made a motion to approve Matt Roche's bid of \$15,469.00 annually for a period of (3) three years. Christopher Johnson seconded, no opposition.

Highway Uniforms


Christopher Johnson made a motion to accept Cintas uniform bid for a period of (3) three years. Matthew Puntin seconded, no opposition.

- Gerard Miller requested Noah Choquette check a culvert on Goose Pond Road just past Richardson's as it is "popping up" and has very little gravel covering it.



ORDER FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATIONS

By the Selectboard of the Town of Tyringham, Massachusetts; Notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

**VERIZON NEW ENGLAND INC. and
WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY dba EVERSOURCE ENERGY**

be and they are hereby granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 1st day of April, 2016.

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the following conditions:

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the plan marked—Verizon No. **1A1P3LE**, dated March 28, 2016, filed with said petition. There may be attached to said poles by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed 40 wires and 4 cables and by said **WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY dba EVERSOURCE ENERGY** not to exceed 16 wires and 2 cables and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height of not less than 18 feet from the ground at highway crossings, and not less than 8 feet from the ground elsewhere.


The following are the public ways or parts of ways along which the poles above referred to may be erected, and the number of poles, which may be erected thereon under this order:

GOOSE POND ROAD: Place one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.5X/E.32-1 on the northerly side of Goose Pond Road at a point approximately three hundred thirty-six (336) feet easterly from the center line of Cooper Creek Road.

Reason: Place one (1) jointly owned pole to provide for the distribution of intelligence and telecommunications and for the transmission of high and low voltage electric.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted to each of said Companies to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each may desire for distributing purposes.

I hereby certify that the foregoing order was adopted at a meeting of the Selectboard of the Town of Tyringham, Massachusetts held on the 26 day of April 2016.




To Whom It May Concern,

The Lee School Committee has approved the following 2015-2016 tuition agreement between Lee Public Schools and the Town of Tyringham. Tuition rates will increase by 1.4% to the following amount:

- For the 2015-2016 school year, tuition rates will increase to the following amount (**a total of \$6,422.68 per student**). Tuition increases over subsequent years will be based on the previous year's cost of living average as found in the Department of Labor Northeast Size B/C. Tuition will be capped at a 3% increase annually.
- Should the cost of living index rise above 3.5% two years in a row, the districts agree to reopen discussions and reconsider the formula.

As a means of regularizing fair, gradual increases that will allow for better planning for all parties in determining tuition out-takes and in-takes from year to year, we look forward to our continued relationship in the education of our young people.
