INTERNET: The board decided the school house will be a public area for Wi-Spring. I will speak to Holly Ketron because the board would like a "go to person" to be in charge of this area.

Craig DeSantis of Goosepond Road called to lodge a formal complaint because he cannot get Wi-Spring. His residence is too low and unless he purchases other equipment that would be much higher to grab the signal, he will not get Wi-Spring.

Roger Ketron would like to use the "hot spot" daily for business. The board will ask for a donation toward the heating bill.

SCHOOL--Mr. Jason McCandless- School Superintendent; School Committee members Pam Curtin, Edward Nardi, and Sgt. Patrick Holian were in to discuss school safety. Jake gave an overview of safety measures in the Middle and High School that are currently in place; locked doors and cameras in the front door ways have been in effect since the shootings in PA. All doors are not to be propped open, new protocols have been established for entry with the camera system, New measures since the Newtown elementary school shootings include-armored glass proposals are fourth coming, fire doors are being rekeyed to lock off hall ways, Lee Police have access to security cameras at the schools, a review of safety in a lock down situation, and lock down drills are also practiced. The board told Mr. McCandless that if he needed our officer to contact them. Noah Choquette requested using some overtime toward 2 days off, this was approved by the Selectmen.
