Matt opened the meeting by stating that he was giving full disclosure that he is a member of the Goose Pond Maintenance District and that he works with Sarah Schultz. Sarah is representing Goose Pond Maintenance District for this RDA.

RDA – Goose Pond Maintenance District, Sarah explained the RDA to the commission. The District wishes to hand harvest invasive plant species in Goose Pond. The pulling would be done by divers. Sarah stated that Goose Pond Maintenance would file a Notice of Intent if the Commission would prefer.

Al asked what plants would be pulled. Sarah replied that it would be strictly invasive species of plants.

Mike asked when the pulling would stop. Matt explained that there was a budget for this project.

Matt described where the harvesting would take place. If people see the harvesting and want to pull plants from their property they would have to go to the Conservation Commission first.

Matt made a motion to grant a Negative 3. The motion was seconded and unanimous approval.
