Curtin 121 Main Rd, Charpentier of #99 Main Rd., V. Deyeso of 8 Webster Rd. A question arose over the permit for J. Wiley of 26A Stonebridge Way, and Robin will be checking with the Selectmen.**

**Robin will also be finding more information concerning the Cemetery bylaw change proposal.**

**Berkshire Regional Planning Commission rep Ed Nardi reported there is a possibility that the Lee section of the Tyringham road proposed reconstruction may come up for bid this October.**

**Discussion then turned to the possibility of the necessity for creating bylaws for Wind Turbines and Solar Panels. It was suggested that Ed obtain copies of existing bylaws created by the Planning Commission for other towns. Some discussion with the Selectmen was also indicated.**
