He stated he owned only a 1/2 acre and is limited as to where he can install a well. Matthew Puntin will work with Mark Curtin as to the location of this new well.

51 Cooper Creek Road - A Mold report was received by the Board of Health. ECO Genesis is the company that completed the testing. In summary it states that although some individuals may be allergic or sensitive to some of the species of fungi identified, the general population would not be expected to experience adverse health effects at the levels detected.

We will ask Larry Gould for an update on his building code violations for this property.

TRANSFER STATION:




