

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
TOWN OF TYRINGHAM

November 13, 2012

COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

Berkshire SS:

To any of the Constables of the Town of Tyringham, in said County,

GREETINGS:

IN THE NAME of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Tyringham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Tuesday, November 13, 2012 at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1.

To see if the Town will vote, pursuant to G.L. c.164, §134(a), to authorize the Board of Selectmen to initiate the process to aggregate the electric load of interested electricity consumers within the Town of Sheffield and enter into agreements for services to facilitate the sale and purchase of electric energy and other related services, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2.

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or otherwise provide the sum of \$5,000.00 or any other amount to purchase new radios for the highway department and Town Office due to the narrow banding laws that take effect on January 1, 2013, or take any other action in respect thereto.


ARTICLE 3.

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to take all necessary and appropriate action to establish and to maintain, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 164 of the General Laws and in accordance with the rules, regulations and orders of the Department of Public Utilities and the Department of Telecommunications & Cable, a municipal lighting plant for all purposes allowable under the laws of the Commonwealth, including without limitation the operation of a telecommunications system and any related services, or to take any other action relative thereto.

AND YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to serve this Warrant by posting copies thereof at the Post Office, Union Church, Town Hall and Bulletin Board at Goose Pond, in said Town, not less than fourteen (14) days before the time of holding said meeting.


HEREOF, FAIL NOT, and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon unto our Town Clerk on or before said day and hour.


