

Minutes of Meeting June 18, 2013

In attendance: Ed Nardi, Bill Dillof, Alan Wilcox, Mike McCauley, Mimi Crandall, Julia Gray

1. Julia Gray RDA – 46 Lakeside Drive, The Grays wish to repair replace footing drain: Excavate down to bottom of footing. Repair drain and waterproof foundation. Extend drain to daylight toward lake. The trench would be 6'-8' deep. The dirt that is from the trench would be put in the front of the house. There would be trench along the right side of the house which is on a slope. The Grays are hiring a company out of Chicopee. There are no trees being cut to access. They will use a small excavator. The Commission requested a tarp over the dirt pile, as well as double row of silt fence and hay bales around the dirt on the lake side of the pile. The proposed work should not take a long time to complete. Ed Nardi moved that the work is a Negative 2 is within an area subject to protection under the act but will not remove, fill, dredge, or alter that area. Al Wilcox seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous.
2. The request for a Certificate of Compliance from White Engineering Inc., on behalf of Julie R. Goldberg, 53 Goose Pond Rd. was withdrawn.
3. Berkshire Natural Resources Council Inc. seeking signatures on the Municipal Certification for a Conservation Restriction. The application was reviewed by the Commission. It was the conclusion of the members that the role of the Conservation Commission was to see that the wetland regulations were upheld. Ed Nardi so moved that the restriction protects natural habitat and preserves open space and will provide for scenic enjoyment of the general public and in consideration of foregoing this Commission finds that the proposed is in the public interest. Al Wilcox seconded the motion. Unanimous in favor.
4. The Commission voted to renew their annual membership to the Massachusetts Association of Conservation Commissions. Mimi will submit the annual dues invoice to Molly.
