

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

Tuesday October 22, 2019 (following Health meeting). 7:03 PM

Board members present: James Consolati, Matthew Puntin, Michael Curtin & Molly Curtin-Schaefer.

Mail was read, previous minutes and treasury warrants were approved.

Mail reviewed: Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) program, Class Action Lawsuit payment to the Town for PILT underpayments, Mass DOT Bridge Inspection report for T-10-003, T-10-006 bridges. Building permits #480, 481, 482.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No public present.

James Consolati stated the next meeting would be after daylight savings time ends so the starting time on November 12, will be 5:30 for review of mail and Board of Health starting at 6 pm.

BROADBAND: John Decker from Charter contacted Jim Consolati to outline costs for drops inside and outside the Town's right of way. After a discussion regarding the drops it was decided to meet with John Decker again to confirm the Jerusalem Road (near Breakneck Road) power sources. We will place this item on the next agenda.

MASS CULTURAL COUNCIL: James Consolati signed the contract for the grant funds for our local cultural council. No opposition.

LEASH LAW: A discussion ensued regarding the Town not having a leash law. John Springstube gave the Town a sample of a law in relation to dogs, fees, license, shots etc. Matthew Puntin made a motion to place this general by law on the Annual Town Meeting warrant and let the Town vote on this issue. James Consolati seconded, no opposition.
