
#### Attachment A PROJECT NARRATIVE

#### 1.0 Introduction

The Town of Tyringham proposes to perform scour repair work to the stream channel of Hop Brook adjacent to the foundations of the Main Road Bridge.

The purpose of the Main Road Bridge Scour Repair Project is to perform repairs to ensure proper performance of the transportation infrastructure. The proposed repair work is intended to reestablish the stream bed which is needed to protect the bridge foundation from future scour during extreme water events. The length of the project is approximately 30 feet.

The project area for this NOI filing is shown on the locus map (Figure 1).

#### 2.0 Site Overview

Using the locus and available maps, GIS datalayers, as mapped by the Commonwealth's Office of Geographic Information (MassGIS), were overlaid on the project locus to determine the presence/absence and general location of environmental resources within, adjacent and proximate to the "Main Road Bridge over Hop Brook Scour Repair" project limits in Tyringham.

#### **Wetland Resources**

As shown in Figure 2, based on the DEP Wetlands datalayer, the proposed repair work is located within and adjacent to wetland resource areas. As such, the proposed work is located within land under water (LUW). Other wetland resource areas including riverfront, bank, borderline vegetated wetland and land subjected to flooding will not be impacted.

In order to minimize impacts to the LUW, the proposed work will meet the general performance standards set forth by 310 CMR 10.54 (4) which includes the following:

- a. Any proposed work within the Land Under Water Bodies and Waterways shall not impair the following:
  - 1. The water carrying capacity within the defined channel, which is provided by said land in conjunction with the banks;

In order to maintain water carrying capacity of the stream, the contractor will not be allowed to obstruct more than 50% of the flow of the stream channel while doing in-stream construction activities. Once complete, the natural stream bed will be reestablished.

2. Ground and surface water quality;

The water quality impacts from the proposed work will be mitigated with the use of floating silt fence. The floating silt fence will encompass the area of work which will aid in the containment of any siltation or debris from the proposed work. Furthermore, work in the waterway will be restricted to low flow periods (July 1 – September 30) and to small hand equipment.

3. The capacity of said land to provide breeding habitat, escape cover and food for fisheries; and

4. The capacity of said land to provide important wildlife habitat functions.

This will be maintained.

b. May issue an Order to maintain or improve boat channels within Land Under Water Bodies and Waterways when said work is designed and carried out using the best practical measures so as to minimize adverse effects.

#### 3.0 Proposed Activities

Maintenance repair work will be performed on the following bridge:



Work involves installing a scour countermeasure system underneath the Main Road Bridge to protect its foundation from further undermining. The stages of work include:

- Install a floating silt fence for debris containment during work activity,
- Excavate the stream bed as needed to install riprap,
- Lay out geotextile fabric covered by crushed stone,
- Install groutbags and pour grout within undermine area of the existing footing,
- Install remaining groutbags to fill in scour hole,
- Then reestablish the remaining streambed with riprap on top of the crushed stone.

The placement of the grout bags and rip rap material will fill the existing scour hole and reestablish the stream bed to its natural elevation. No net fill of the natural stream will occur.





# EXISTING STREAM PROFILE ALONG WEST ABUT.



#### Dear Applicant:

The Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program of the Massachusetts Division of Fisheries & Wildlife (the "Division") received the MESA Project Review Checklist, plans (dated 11/15/2016) and other required materials for review pursuant to the Massachusetts Endangered Species Act (MESA) (MGL c.131A) and its implementing regulations (321 CMR 10.00).

The MESA is administered by the Division, and prohibits the Take of state-listed species. The Take of state-listed species is defined as "in reference to animals...harm...kill...disrupt the nesting, breeding, feeding or migratory activity...and in reference to plants...collect, pick, kill, transplant, cut or process...Disruption of nesting, breeding, feeding, or migratory activity may result from, but is not limited to, the modification, degradation, or destruction of Habitat" of state-listed species (321 CMR 10.02).

The Division has determined that this Project, as currently proposed, will occur **within** the actual habitat of the Wood Turtle (*Glyptemys insculpta*), a species of Special Concern. This species and their habitats are protected in accordance with the rare species provisions of the WPA and the MESA.

Based on the information provided and the information contained in our database, the Division finds that a portion of this project, as currently proposed, <u>must be conditioned</u> in order to avoid a prohibited <u>Take of state-listed species (321 CMR 10.18(2)(a))</u>. To avoid a prohibited Take of state-listed species, the following condition must be met:

<u>Turtle Protection Plan:</u> Prior to any work, the Applicant shall submit a Turtle Protection Plan, prepared by a qualified biologist, to the Division for review and approval. Said Protection Plan must be **approved in writing by the Division prior to the start of Work.** Please note that a Scientific Collection Permit must be obtained from the NHESP to handle state-listed species. The Division is available to provide guidance in the development of the plan.

Provided the above-noted condition is fully implemented and there are no changes to the project plans, this project will not result in a Take of state-listed species. We note that all work is subject to the antisegmentation provisions (321 CMR 10.16) of the MESA. This determination is a final decision of the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife pursuant to 321 CMR 10.18. Any changes to the proposed project or any additional work beyond that shown on the site plans may require an additional filing with the Division pursuant to the MESA. This project may be subject to further review if no physical work is commenced within five years from the date of issuance of this determination, or if there is a change to the project.
