PUBLIC COMMENT: NONE

TEBB – A discussion ensued regarding a posting on the T.E.B.B. This was a controversial article regarding ticks and illness. A doctor who is a resident in Tyringham contact us and asked why we would post such a controversial article on our web site. The TEBB is a private site and not affiliated with the Town. Many people think the Town of Tyringham run the TEBB. For this reason the Selectmen suggest that Adrienne Cosel should list on the top of all postings the following: “The TEBB is a private organization not affiliated with the Town of Tyringham”

2018 Freightliner Truck Bid: A discussion ensued regarding the VH93 state contract as well as the Greater Boston Police Council bids. Noah Choquette stated working with the equipment committee they decided to spec a Freightliner. The International truck has a cheaper engine and some local towns have a class action law suit against them. The Mac was comparable in price however, Tyringham has dumped a lot of money into their Mac. Peterbuilt was out of Pennsylvania and to far to run for repair and parts.

James Consolati made a motion to purchase the Freightliner that was specked out by our equipment committee and Matthew Puntin seconded, no opposition.

PRIVATE ROADS:

Hemlock Road – Noah Choquette asked the Board if they wanted him to create a list of road issues for Hemolok Road. He was instructed to draft this list and it would be reviewed at a later date.

LAKESIDE DRIVE & RIDGE STREET: – Joe Janis was in to ask the Selectmen to grade Lakeside Drive and Ridge Street. A discussion ensued regarding this issue. Further discussion will be held on this topic.

Michael Curtin made a motion that James Consolati remain Chairman, Matthew Puntin as Clerk, Matthew Puntin seconded, no opposition. Michael Curtin will become member.




It was agreed to start the June 13, meeting at 6 pm. The Board will consider a time change for summer meetings.




