LAND SURVEY – SCHOOL HOUSE: Mike Curtin requested himself from this discussion. A discussion ensued regarding the survey from Foresight Land dated August 2023. It was agreed to visually place steaks with flags on the 3 “corners” of the school yard. The location of the property lines will be discussed at the next Select Board meeting.

JUNETEENTH: June 19th is a federal holiday and it was added to the holiday list. Matthew Puntin made a motion to add Juneteenth to the list of town holidays and James Consolati seconded. No opposition.



Molly Curtin-Schaefer advised the Board that a “Mill & Fill” paving job was out to bid. This project will run from the Tyringham/Lee town line to approximately 75 Main Road. The bid opening is September 20, 2023 at 1:00 pm.

Noah Choquette discussed other paving projects for next year, crack sealing, and tree projects.

Ann Gallo asked about storage for the Town's Historical documents. The school house is not climate-controlled and the documents, books etc. are deteriorating. It was agreed to investigate climate-controlled pods. This item will be placed on the next agenda.
