Treasurer warrants and previous minutes were approved.

PAVING: A discussion ensued about this construction season's paving projects. It was unanimously approved to pave Main Road from the park bridge to possibly the Lee town line depending on the pricing.

Also discussed was the use of salt on the boat ramp. The ramp must be salted or sanded as it is a source of water for fire protection. Noah Choquette will discuss this issue with Terry Smith of the Massachusetts Fish & Wildlife when they meet next week.
