OLD BUSINESS: Updates -

GREEN COMMUNITY: James Consolati met with Steven Cowell regarding this designation and the "as of right zoning" we have to enact. Mr. Cowell agreed the Transfer Station is the area to designate for that purpose.

<u>SCHOOL HOUSE:</u> A discussion ensued regarding the rehab of the school house. The foundation, bones, siding, windows and hiring an engineer/architect. It was decided that Phase I will be started and this will be the foundation of the building. The Board of Selectmen will consult and then an architect will be hired to submit a plan on the "scope of work".

<u>HIGHWAY DEPT</u>: Noah Choquette stated this year he has used more sand than any other year he has been Road Supt. this is due to the many ice storms. He also stated our truck is in however, the salesman never told the builder it was coming and therefore no parts were ordered for our truck. New delivery date for the truck is end of April 2020.
