<u>Mail reviewed</u>: The proposed Dog Control Bylaw from the Planning Board. The FY22 insurance policies: Automobile Fleet Schedule, Property & Location Coverage. ## 7:00 PM PUBLIC HEARING - discontinuing the maintenance on Brace Road

The Town maintains Brace Road to the turnaround adjacent to 9 Brace Road. The portion of the road past that has minimal maintenance. It will continue to be "open" but is very rugged and steep. The Town will post a sign that states "unmaintained road travel at your own risk". The Town of Monterey does not maintain their portion of Brace Road. This is a liability issue that the Town wants to formalize thru this hearing.

Mr. William E. Martin from Martin & Oliveria, LLP attended. He represents Ruth Swart and wanted clarification that Brace Road would continue to be a public way. A discussion ensued and the status of this road will not change, this just formalized the fact that the Town of Tyringham does not maintain this road to a standard for everyday travel.

Rod and Nancy Hickey attended. Mr. Hickey asked if he would still be able to take a tractor up Brace Road to his property and the answer is yes.

James Consolati made a motion to discontinue the maintenance of Brace Road past the turnaround adjacent to 9 Brace Road to the Monterey town line. Matthew Puntin seconded, no opposition.

OTHER BUSINESS: COLA was removed from this agenda.

The Town ordered 2 more speed signs. A discussion as to the placement of them ensued. It was decided to locate one between 28-34 Main Road and one near Fenn Road. It was discussed to see what the logs on the 2 current speed signs read. Noah will look into retrieving the logs.
