ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote up to \$30,000.00 out
of Free Cash, or any other amount to be used with
Chapter 90 funds for the paving of Monterey Road
or take any other action in respect thereto.

Unanimous vote from Free Cash up to \$30,000.00

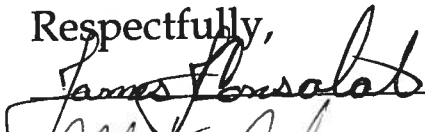
15 registered voters attended. Meeting adjourned 6:06 p.m.

Given under our hands at Tyringham, Massachusetts, this Twenty Seventh day of November in the year of Our Lord, Two Thousand Eighteen.

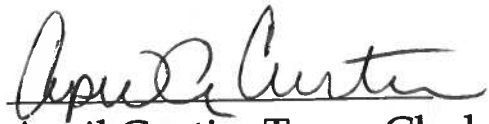
