*Shall the town vote to have its elected Treasurer become an appointed Treasurer of the town? Yes \_\_\_ No \_\_\_*

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to change the Tax Collector position from an elected Tax Collector to an appointed Tax Collector by the Board of Selectmen, with the following ballot question, or take any action in relation thereto.

*Shall the town vote to have its elected Tax Collector become an appointed Tax Collector of the town? Yes \_\_\_ No \_\_\_*


