IN THE NAME of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are  
hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of  
Tyningham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Town  
Hall in said Town on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at seven o'clock in  
the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of  
up to \$3,420.00 or any other sum, out of Free Cash  
for the purpose of extending the Library hours by 6  
hours each week.

**Unanimous Free Cash Vote - up to \$3,420.00**

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of  
\$3,073.18 or any other sum, out of Free Cash for the  
purpose of refunding the Tyningham Volunteer Fire  
Company for FY19 Real Estate Taxes.

**Motion passes - Free Cash Vote \$3,073.18 (39 yes - 2 no)**

**AND YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to serve this Warrant by posting copies thereof at the Post Office, Union Church, Town Hall and Bulletin Board at Goose Pond, in said Town, not less than fourteen (14) days before the time of holding said meeting.**

HEREOF, FAIL NOT, and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon unto our Town Clerk on or before said day and hour.

Given under our hands at Tyringham, Massachusetts, this third day of September in the year of Our Lord, Two Thousand Nineteen.


