After every State Election in which the office of President appears on the ballot, state law requires that a post-election audit be held of a random selection of 3% of all precincts in Massachusetts. Tyringham was one of the precincts chosen by random draw.

- At the audit, tellers will recount the ballots that were counted at the close of polls on election day. There are 316 ballots to be recounted.
- Once the count is complete, numbers will be compared to election night tallies and a Post Election report will be completed and filed with the state.

This count is open to the public, and seating will be designated for those who wish to witness this count. There will be no pictures and no disruption allowed during this process as we are a hand count town and the tellers need to have their attention focused on an accurate count. Masks are required to attend.

This meeting agenda is being posted in compliance with Massachusetts' Open Meeting Law as noted below.

G.L. c. 30A § 20©; 940 CMR 29.03(2)-(4)
