To cast their votes by Australian Ballot for candidates for the following offices to be placed on the Annual Town Election Ballot:

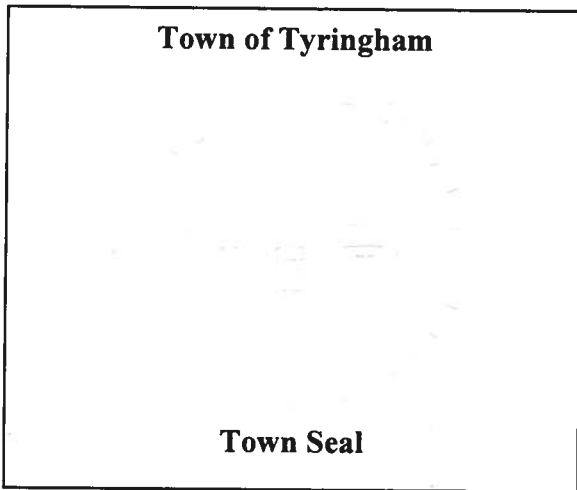
- One Moderator for one-year term

- Treasurer for one-year term


The selectmen give notice that the polls will be open for the Caucus of the Town Officers at 11 AM on said day and will close at 1 PM on said day.


