- One School Committee for three-year term**

The selectmen give notice that the polls will be open for the election of the Town Officers at 12pm on said day and will close at 7 pm.

This Warrant will be served by posting four copies in Tyringham, one each at Union Church, the Town Hall, the Post Office and the Bulletin Board at Goose Pond, at least seven days before the time of said caucus.






