**To cast their votes at the Annual Town Election for candidates for the following offices:**

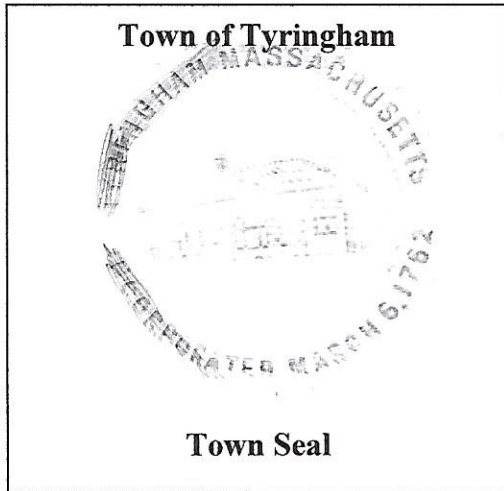
- One Moderator for one-year term**


