ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of up to \$20,000.00 or any other sum, out of Free Cash for the purpose of purchasing a 2000 gallon 1990 International 4900 4 x 2 Water Tender/with pump for the Fire Company or take any other action in relation thereto.





Given under our hands at Tyringham, Massachusetts, this Twenty Seventh day of November in the year of Our Lord, Two Thousand Eighteen.






